## **PM Best Practices Checklist**



## What Should I Do?

Follow these project management best practices to avoid project failure at your SMB.



Establish a Project Management Office
Formalize a center for project governance
Standardize workflow processes across organization
Dictate and follow a PMO charter
Define Organizational PM Hierarchy
Create an odd-numbered core decision-making group (so votes have a clear winner)
<ul> <li>Make sure the core group understands goals and has a clear understanding of business strategy</li> <li>Have a set schedule for approving/denying change requests, e.g., deliberations can't last longer than one week</li> </ul>
Create Stakeholder Management Plan
Define roles and responsibilities
Analyze level of interest in and impact on the project
Develop stakeholder communication plans
Don't Forget About Quality
Acknowledge inherent project risks
Create risk-return profile to assess if your SMB can tolerate failure
Remember that cutting scope, cost or schedule will impact quality
Conduct Project Audits
Evaluate current project progress as it aligns with business goals
Ask if expected results still deliver value
Address issues and concerns raised by stakeholders
